







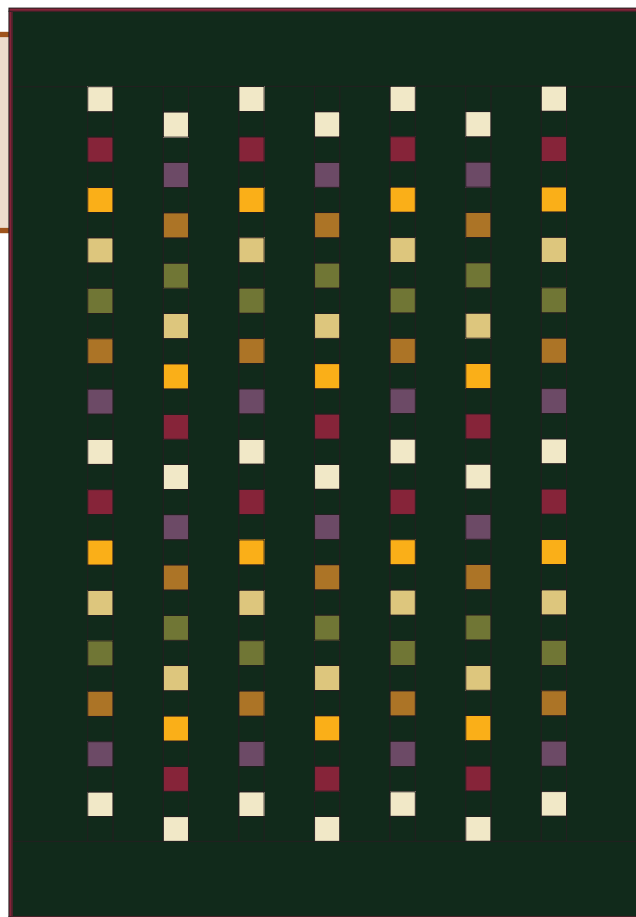
Pattern Basics

We encourage breaking the rules, but here are a few things you might want to keep in mind:









- Please read through **all** the instructions carefully **before** beginning a project. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this pattern.
- All instructions use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.
- All fabrics are sewn right sides together; unless otherwise stated.

Common Quilting Acronyms:

FQ = fat quarter (18" x 22")	WS = wrong side of fabric
WOFQ = width of fat quarter	RS = right side of fabric
WOF = width of fabric	HST = half square triangle
LOF = length of fabric	QST = quarter square triangle

Cutting Suggestions

Yardage below is diagrammed on 40" width selvage to selvage. FQs are diagrammed on 20" width.



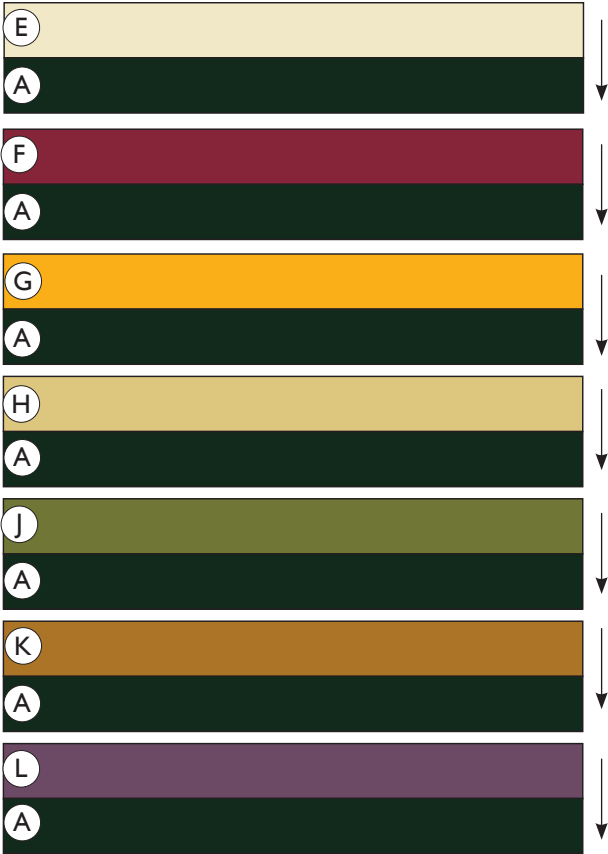
Directions

Block Assembly:

1. Sew an **A** to an **E**. Press in the direction of the arrow. Cut every 2-1/2".

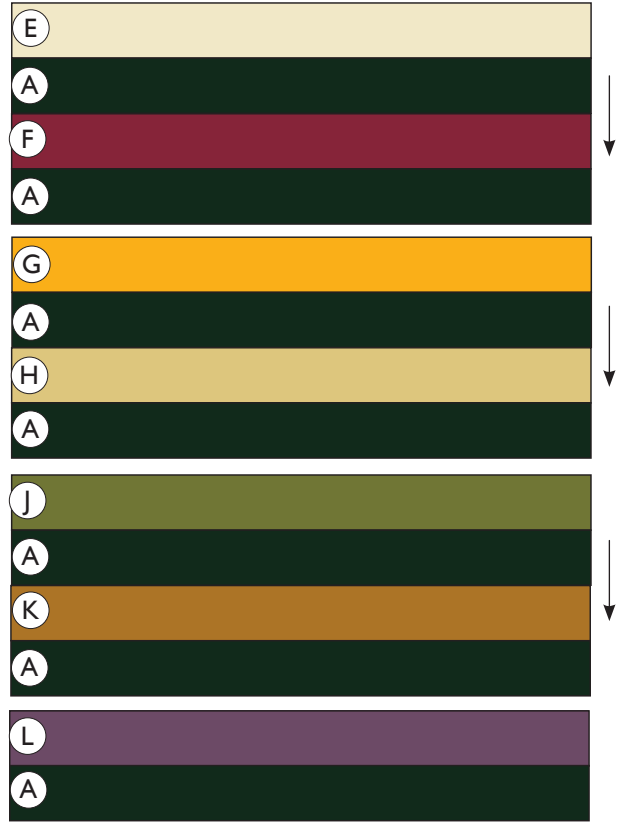


2. Sew an **E** to an **A**. Press.
 Cut the length of **F** in half. Sew an **F** to an **A**. Press.
 Sew a **G** to an **A**. Press.
 Sew an **H** to an **A**. Press.
 Sew a **J** to an **A**. Press.
 Sew a **K** to an **A**. Press.
 Sew an **L** to an **A**. Press.
 Repeat to make a second strip set of each combination.



Make 2 of each

3. Sew an **E/A** to an **F/A**. Press.
 Sew a **G/A** to an **H/A**. Press.
 Sew a **J/A** to a **K/A**. Press.



Make 2

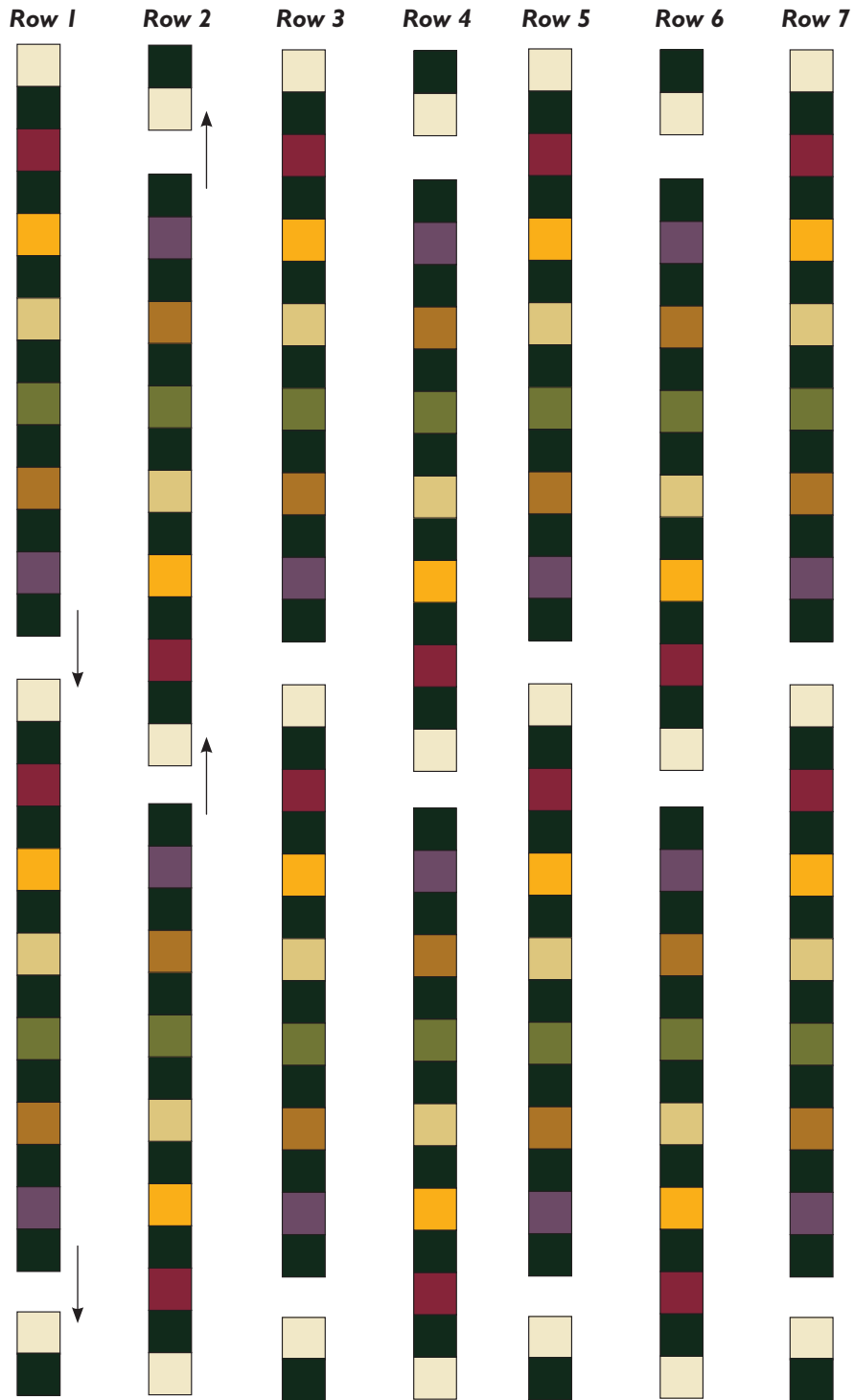
4. Sew the remaining sections together. Press. Cut every 2-1/2".

Make 2 strip sets
Cut 14 ~ 2-1/2" x 28-1/2"

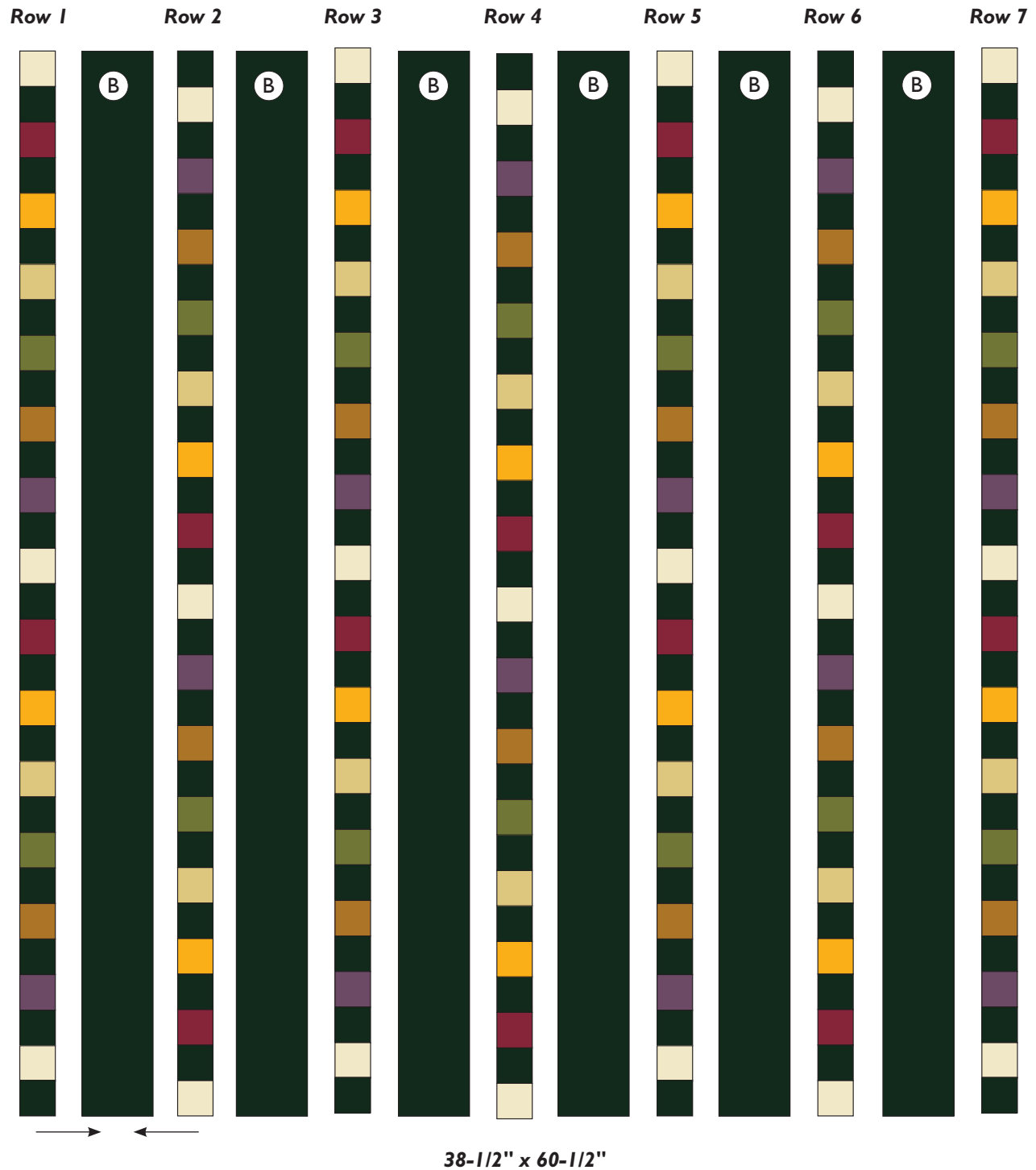
5. Sew two Step 4 units end-to-end as shown for Row 1. Press. Sew a Step 1 **A/E** unit to the lower end of Row 1. Press. Repeat for Rows 2 to 7. Rows 2, 4, and 6 are rotated 180° in the quilt.



Make 7 rows ~ 2-1/2" x 60-1/2"

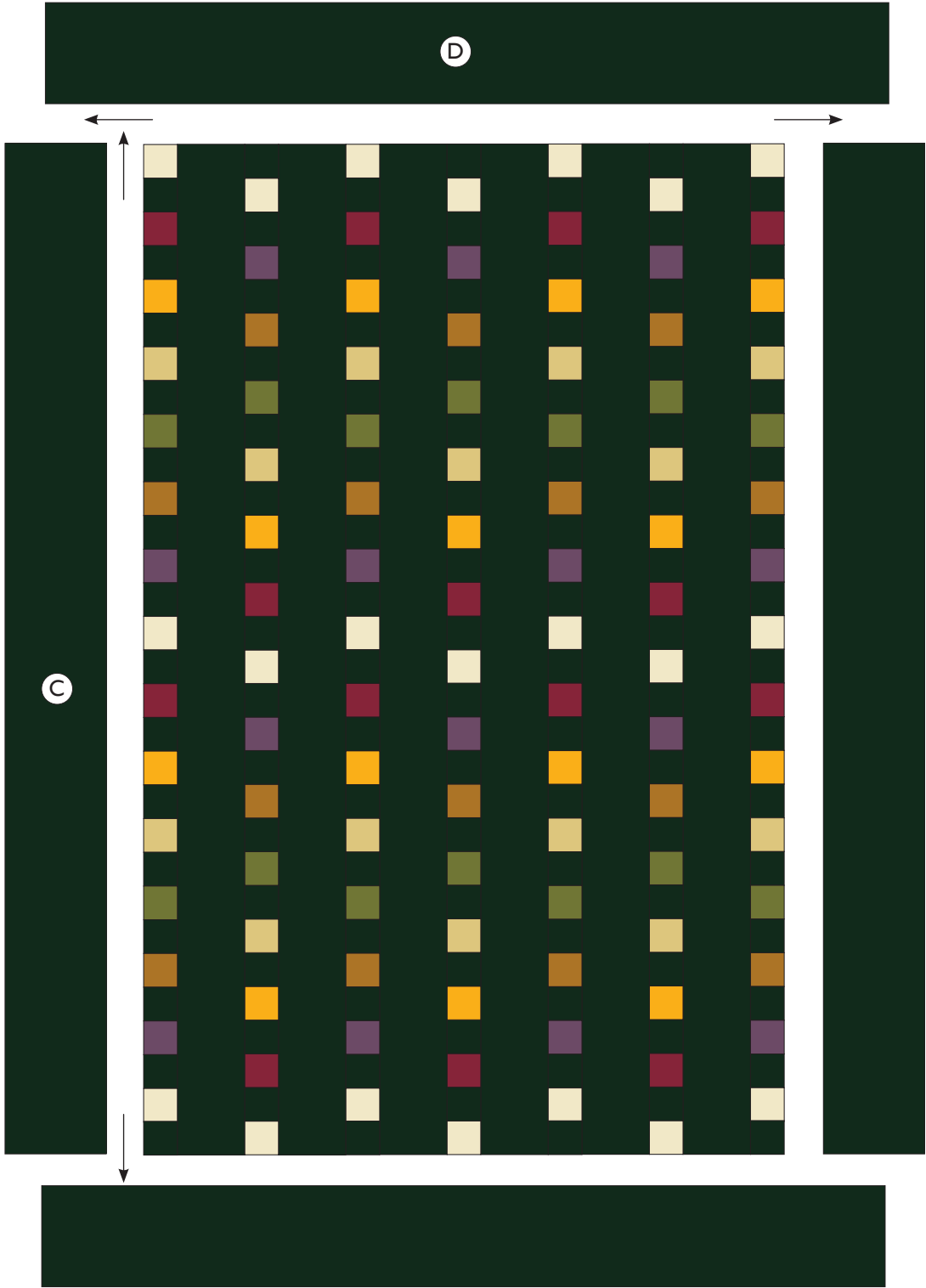
Quilt Body Assembly:

6. After checking that Rows 1 to 7 are arranged as illustrated in Step 5, sew a **B** between each Step 5 Row. Press to the **B**s. *Hint:* Sewing a pieced Row to a **B** will be easier if you turn the units so the Row's seam allowances face away from the sewing machine needle.



Adding Borders:

- 7. Sew a **C** to each side. Press.
- 8. Sew a **D** to the top and bottom. Press.

Finishing the Quilt:

9. Layer backing WS up, batting, and top WS down. Quilt. Bind with a 1/4" seam allowance.
